Camp Rules

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF EACH CAMPER TO BECOME FAMILIAR WITH AND ABIDE BY THE CAMP RULES

Violation of camp rules if deemed serious enough by Camp Director may result in camper being sent home at parent's expense!

- No one is to leave camp without permission
- No tobacco in any form, alcoholic beverages or drugs (without prescription)
- No fires
- **Kamp Kinship allows no pets**
- No fireworks
- No guns or knives
- No defacing or cutting of trees, shrubs, building or grounds
- No profanity, either spoken or written
- No CD players, iPods, Cell Phones, etc.

WHAT TO WEAR

Modesty is expected at all times!

- Bring warm clothing for nighttime campfires & outings. Warm jackets, sweaters or coats
- Bring tennis shoes & boots for sports and hiking
- No spandex clothing, short shorts, tank tops, halter or midriff tops will be allowed
- No clothing bearing liquor advertisement, suggestive sayings, etc.

What to Bring

- Warm Bedding — the nights get very cool. Bring a warm sleeping bag and pillow. Bunks and mattresses are provided in cabins.
- Bible, Pencils, notebook
- Flashlight
- Towels
- Softball glove or other sports equipment
- Fishing pole (for campers under 14 years old)
- Toilet articles (soap, toothbrush, deodorant, etc.)
- Swimsuit and towel
- Cover-Up
- **At least \$15 for Canteen is suggested**
